FEEES FOR DISPOSAL

CASH IS PREFERRED FORM OF PAYMENT

Residents, New Lower Price & Lower Minimum

- \$7 for each 2 gallons or 2 pounds

Businesses:

- Must pre-register; detail items & sizes
- Can service very small quantity generator, VSQG firms
- Fees depend on products & volume.

HOW TO TRANSPORT SAFELY

- Keep materials in original containers.
- Tighten caps and lids.
- Sort by type.
- Pack in sturdy upright boxes and pad with newspaper.
- Never smoke while handling hazardous materials.
- Transport less than 55 gallons a trip
- **NEVER MIX CHEMICALS**

OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED

Fees may apply

- Batteries-automotive & other lead acid
- Batteries-rechargeable & button
- Electronics, TV's, computers, monitors, appliances, most items with a cord (\$)
- Fluorescent bulbs (\$)
- Latex Paint - Can be treated as regular trash after completely dried (\$)
- Mercury thermometers
- Printer ink and toner cartridges
- Thermostats

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Items to put in your regular trash

- Alkaline Batteries
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Empty Paint Cans
- Infectious / Biological Wastes
- Smoke Detectors

Check trash facility or Board of Health

- Asbestos >55 gal. drum. Smaller items wetted & double bagged are acceptable.
- Bulky / Non-Hazardous Items
- Commercial / Industrial Waste
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Construction Materials
- Fire Extinguishers
- Needles / Syringes - get container & return to Nashoba BOH 978-772-3335
- Propane, Other Flammable Gas
- Radioactive Waste
- Tires / PCB's

Police Department:

- Ammunition, fireworks, explosives
- Prescription medicines, 24hrs, anyone at: Ayer, Bolton, Clinton, Groton, Harvard, Lancaster, Littleton, Lunenburg, Pepperell, Stow, and Townsend. (no liquids)
