

Meeting Minutes

Thursday April 28, 2016, 6pm

1. Call to Order: Meeting called to order 6:10pm
2. Attending: Rob Bowen, Nancy Gray, Cathy Hennessy, Michelle Smith, Kathy Herrick
3. Public Comment: None
4. Minutes from March 10th Chair entertained motion to approve minutes. Seconded by Ms. Hennessy. All attending voted to approve minutes.
5. Minutes from March 31st – Amend minutes remove “infer”. Chair entertained motion to approve amended minutes. Seconded by Ms. Hennessy. All attending voted to approve minutes.
6. Minutes from April 14th – Section f-amend Article VI. Chair entertained motion to approve amended minutes. Seconded by Ms. Hennessy. All attending voted to approve minutes.
7. Chair advised the committee that no response was received from letters to all departments for feedback.
8. Chair advised that the Town Manager expressed interest in amending Section 3 ‘to remove 2/3 vote’. Discussion by committee of intent for this special section. Chair entertained motion to repeal Section 3 to match Section 6. So moved by C. Hennessy and seconded by N. Gray. All voted in favor.
9. Review of Bylaws & Charter.
 - a. Article 10 Section 3 fine amounts are under review by the Chief of Police. Pending feedback
 - b. Article 12 Sections 1,2 are now covered by the Town Charter. Section 3 committee discussed and Chair moved to repeal as it conflicts with Town Charter. Seconded by C. Hennessy. All attending voted to repeal Sections 1-3.
 - c. Article 12 Section 4-requires further study.
 - d. Article 16-Zoning enforcement. Chair will contact department for feedback.
 - e. Article 17-18 Not recommending changes.
 - f. Article 19-Special Town Meeting held November 2015 made update.
 - g. Article 20-Not recommending changes.
 - h. Article 21-will be addressed at May 2016 Town Meeting
 - i. Article 22-is contained in Town Charter section 3 – 6 (a) and 3 – 6 (b). Chair moved to repeal as it conflicts with Town Charter. Seconded by C. Hennessy. All attending voted to repeal
