Kevin Richie met with the board on behalf of the owner. Chris Kimball, owner of the property was also present. This system is in failure due to high ground water. This property is currently served by a well but is to be connected to public water. The existing well is to be destroyed. A reduction in groundwater from five feet to four feet is being requested. This offset will allow the system to be a gravity system.

After discussion and on Motion by Auge and second by Jewell, the requested variance was approved. All in favor.

STORMWATER TASK FORCE

Board Member Jim Auge reported that there has not been a meeting since his last report. He advised that the Task Force is considering looking at regionalizing with neighboring communities. Mr. Auge will continue to keep the Board UPDATED.

SEPTIC REPAIR LOAN PROGRAM
