Sub-Committee Meeting Notes
December 1, 2009

1. J. Londa reported on bid process for photo-voltaic panels planned for municipal buildings. Bids were due today at 2PM. Only 1 bid was received and it was delivered later than the 2 PM deadline. Bid received was from Green Bridge Co. and limited the bid proposal to a 90kw system on 1 building, the Turkey Hill Middle School.
2. A letter was received from Moss Hollow Solar explaining their reason for not submitting a formal bid. Specifically, with government funding unavailable at the present time they felt that the project as proposed would not be economically viable.
3. J. Londa reviewed a spreadsheet he prepared on the basis of the Green Bridge proposal noting that without the government reimbursement the project would not be beneficial to the Town. It did show that a 15 year proposal was the most advantageous to the Town.
4. The Green Bridge bid information was felt to be helpful to J. Londa and his grant proposal due in Boston by 12/7/09.
5. J. Londa will send a letter to Green Bridge thanking them for their effort in bidding the project and telling them that the Committee is taking their bid under advisement for discussion at their next meeting.
6. Briefly discussed Solar & Wind By-law articles for this evening's Town meeting. S. Marsden will speak on the article.
