There has been no demolition delay requests received.

The Planning Board will consider at least two requests at the May 9, 2016 meeting: 1) the request to install a Safelite, at 39 Massachusetts Avenue, and, 2) a petition requesting permission to cut trees down for a driveway at 233 Lancaster Avenue. Although neither issue is particularly a Historical Commission matter, the safety of motorists exiting from or passing by this proposed driveway on Lancaster Avenue was discussed. Cullen Dwyer expressed his intention to attend this Planning Board meeting.

Becky Lantry is developing a plan to have bronze markers for historical residences available for distribution to those interested.

Amory Phelps reiterated David Grossman, the Editor of the *Lunenburg Ledger*, needs the *Historically Speaking* articles to be received by the first Tuesday of the month in which the article is to appear.

Becky Lantry presented two newspaper articles concerning the Community Preservation Act for discussion: one a town's favorable implementation of the Act and the other a more unfavorable critique of this Act.
