

**Minutes for Joint Session- Board of Selectmen and Sewer Commission Meeting of July 7, 2015 -- Town Hall, 17 Main St.**

Carl Luck called meeting to order 7:15 p.m. (Board of Selectmen (BOS) meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.) Carl Luck opened with comments to the BOS that the Sewer Commission had taken a vote to support the **appointment of John Reynolds to the Sewer Commission**. Jaime Toale requested John Reynolds to come up to the microphone for an interview. John Reynolds, 91 Lancaster Ave., Lunenburg. John stated that he has lived in Lunenburg since 1988. When asked why he wanted to serve on the Sewer Commission, stated that his kids finished with school; He had attended one year's worth of Sewer Commission meetings when the extension to serve his house went through; Stated that based on his observations that he would like to work with the Sewer Commission.

Phyllis Luck stated that she noted John's Project Management experience and thought he would be a good addition to the Sewer Commission and thanked him for volunteering. John Reynolds stated that without Jaime Toale's contribution, the extension on Lancaster which serves his home might not have happened and that as a result of that extension he understood how sewer works. Jaime Toale stated as a result of working with Mr. Reynolds on the Lancaster Avenue extension that he could vouch for Mr. Reynolds and that he would support his appointment to the Sewer Commission. Robert Ebersole stated that he was on the Sewer Commission back when Mr. Reynolds was involved and met with him previously. Ebersole stated that he was off the Sewer Commission before the project was finished, but could attest to Reynolds' commitment and contribution. Ebersole noted that Reynolds would be the only other person on the Sewer Commission currently on sewer service and thought that would be a good thing.

Reynolds was asked if he would be available for continued service when the time came for him to be reelected to the position, Mr. Reynolds responded that he would be available.

Board of Select member Robert Ebersole made the **motion to appoint John Reynolds to the open Sewer Commission position, Paula Bertram seconded. The vote was unanimous of all Board of Selectmen and Sewer Commissioners present.**

Jaime Toale stated that there were more vacancies in town and encouraged more volunteers to come forward.

**Adjournment** -Carl Luck made a **motion to adjourn the Sewer Commission meeting at 7:30 p.m., Mike Nault seconded. Vote unanimous.**
